- 1. Dapper Mr. Frank is all dressed up and has your take out order
- 2. On this landmark ride, the red and the blue are swinging in the sky
- 3. Giant pinwheels are at the entrance to this place awhirl with amusements
- 4. This retired ride's circular car was known as the bagel in the sky
- 5. There's definitely something fishy going on here
- 6. Built in the Roaring '20s, this ride's 85 foot tall, 60-degree drop is still a thrill
- 7. Look for an enormous red flower in the sky and you'll find this retired ride
- 8. It's open year round and you'll never get bored walking here
- 9. It's 3 miles long and jammed with visitors on the Fourth of July
- 10. In the 1920s, a nickel would have gotten you here. Now it costs \$2.25
